ORDINANCE NO. 2007 - 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, KENTUCKY, REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 2003-4; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO HAVE JUNK CARS; CONTAINING CERTAIN DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE; SETTING FORTH PROCEDURES FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE; SETTING FORTH FINES AND COURT COSTS FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND OTHER MATTERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, GREENUP COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It is hereby declared to be a public nuisance to permit the parking, storage or leaving of any vehicle of any kind which is abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, rusted, junked, partially dismantled, inoperative condition, unlicensed and/or untagged, whether attended or not, anywhere within the City Limits of the City of Worthington, Kentucky, for a period of time in excess of twenty-three (23) days, which said twenty-three (23) days need not be continuous. The only exception hereto shall be that it shall not be a violation of this Ordinance to keep such a vehicle in a completely enclosed building where said vehicle is totally out of public sight, nor shall it be a violation to keep said vehicle on any property which is zoned for use as a junkyard or other permissible zoning categories.

SECTION 2: As used in this Ordinance, the following words have the following meaning:

- a. "Vehicle" as used in this Ordinance shall mean any vehicle which is self propelled and designated to travel on the ground and shall include, but not limited to, automobiles, buses, motor-bikes, motorcycles, motor-scooters, tractors, go-carts, campers and trailers.

SECTION 3: The owner of said vehicle or the person or persons in control of the real property upon which said vehicle is sitting, shall be in violation of this Ordinance if said vehicle meets any of the definitional requirements set forth above, and if said vehicle is located within the City limits of the City of Worthington, Kentucky, for at least twenty-three (23) days regardless of whether or not said days are consecutive and regardless of whether or not said vehicle remains on the same piece of real property.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Worthington Police Department, or any other designee of the Mayor of the City of Worthington, Kentucky.
