ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1988

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING IN CERTAIN AREAS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, KENTUCKY AND RESTRICTING PARKING TO SHORT TERM PARKING IN CERTAIN OTHER AREAS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF WORTHINGTON, KENTUCKY.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Worthington, Kentucky as follows:

SECTION 1. That from and after this date, it shall be illegal for anyone to park any vehicle along Ferry Street from Prospect Avenue to Center Street with the following exceptions:

- (1) Short term, 15 minute parking on the eastern side of Ferry Street in a designated area in front of the City Building and in a designated parking area for police or emergency vehicles, and,
- (2) Short term, 15 minute parking on the eastern side of Ferry Street in the designated area immediately across from the Post Office not to extend past the intersection of Hoffman and Ferry Street to the North and not past the alley adjacent in a southerly direction from the Post Office, and,
- (3) Short term, 30 minute parking on the western side of Ferry Street between Collins Street and the alley running between Collins Street and Center Street, and,
- (4) Short term, 30 minute parking on the eastern side of Ferry Street from the intersection of Court Street and Ferry Street on the north to the alley between Court Street and Market Street on the south, and,
- (5) Such other areas as the Worthington City Council may henceforth designate by duly adopted resolution.

SECTION 2. That each and every violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of \$25.00 together with any applicable court costs incident to the processing of any such violation of this ordinance. Police Officers of the City of Worthington at their discretion may issue a warning to any person found in violation of this ordinance in lieu of actual citation of a violation and imposition of penalty as provided herein.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are specifically hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict only.

SECTION 4. That each section and each sentence of this ordinance is enacted separately and the invalidity and/or unconstitutionality of any one particular sentence and/or section shall not affect the validity and/or constitutionality of any other sentence and/or section.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
